

OUR HISTORY IN BRIEF

The Cities Of London & Westminster Conservative Association

The Association came into being following the redistribution of Parliamentary constituencies in 1948.

Before that the area was covered by three constituencies: Abbey, St George's and the City of London. The Abbey division and the St George division were each represented by one Member of Parliament and the City of London by two.

Sir Harold Webbe, who had represented the old Abbey division from 1938, was elected as the first Member of Parliament for the new constituency in 1950 and continued to represent it until 1959, when he stood down and Sir Harry Hylton-Foster succeeded him.

Sir Harry was elected Speaker in October 1959 and served as both Member and Speaker until his death in 1965. Sir Harry was succeeded by Mr John Smith, who was elected at the ensuing by-election and continued to represent the constituency until 1970. He then decided not to seek re-election and Mr Christopher Tugendhat was elected, retaining his seat in 1974.

In 1976, Mr Tugendhat was appointed a European Commissioner and Mr Peter Brooke was elected as Member of Parliament at the by- election in February 1977.

At the General Elections in 1979, 1983, 1987, 1992 and 1997, Mr Brooke was re-elected to Parliament. For the 1983 election the constituency was extended to include the Hyde Park, Bryanston, Baker Street and Cavendish wards of the City of Westminster. From the 1997 election, the Bayswater and Lancaster Gate wards were also included.

Changes to boundaries for the 2010 General Election saw the Bayswater and Lancaster Gate wards returned to Westminster North constituency and the Bryanston & Dorset Square ward incorporated entirely into the constituency.

Peter Brooke was a member of the Government throughout most of Margaret Thatcher and

John Major's premierships, serving as Whip, in the Department of Education & Science and the Treasury, and as Paymaster General, Secretary of State for Northern Ireland and Secretary of State for National Heritage. He was the Chairman of the Conservative Party from 1987 until 1989. He became a Life Peer in 2001 and served on the Party Board.

The Rt Hon Mark Field was elected as our MP in 2001. Prior to 2010, he served as an Opposition Whip and, successively, as Shadow Minister for London, Shadow Financial Secretary to the Treasury and Shadow Minister for Culture and the Arts.

In the 2010 Parliament, Mr Field served as Chairman of the All-Party Parliamentary Group on Venture Capital & Private Equity and Entrepreneurship and Vice Chairman of the APPGs on Bangladesh and Football.

In March 2015, Mark was appointed to Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, in recognition of his service on the Intelligence and Security Committee, which oversees and scrutinises the work of Britain's intelligence services.

Following the 2015 General Election, Mr Field became Vice Chairman (International) of the Conservative Party. After the 2017 General Election, Mark served as Minister of State for Asia and the Pacific at the Foreign & Commonwealth Office.

Nickie Aiken was elected as our Member of Parliament at the 2019 General Election.


Between April 2020 and December 2020, Nickie served as Parliamentary Private Secretary to the Ministerial Team at the Department for Housing, Communities and Local Government.

In September 2022, Nickie was promoted to Deputy Chair of the Conservative Party, having previously served as Vice-Chair for Women and Affiliated Groups. She uses the role to champion London within the central party, and has taken notable roles of leadership within the 2023 London Mayoral hustings and selection process.





